#### Finance

We are pleased to report a profit for the year. This is entirely thanks to the "Cuppa" and other fundraising events. As a result we are able to hold our charge for member activities such as bus outings Xmas party etc. at £12. We had hoped to use fundraising profits to reduce the fee for member activities such as this - but until the hall itself becomes profitable we are unable to do so. Concerts do at last show a small profit. Add to this the increase in raffle income means the Association itself is in good financial health – thanks to everyone who has donated the quality raffle prizes. However, we have seen an increase in hall operating costs of over £800 this year, at the same time as losing the income from a regular hirer [who simply outgrew our hall] added to the substantial drop of bank interest, our loss for the year to  $30^{th}$  April <u>could have been</u> around £2500. Thank goodness for the "Thursday Drop in for a Cuppa". This venture and two other fundraising activities turned a potential overall loss into a welcome profit. Thanks to all bakers / helpers.
